
CANDIDATES DEBATE Harry Braun vs. John McCain

Independent presidential candidate Harry Braun's vision in 2016 is still focused on replacing all of the fossil and nuclear fuels that are in the final stages of making the Earth uninhabitable, with less than three million wind-powered hydrogen production systems by 2020, which will include the deployment of sea-based "windhsips" that will provide a vast sanctuary for the remaining fish and ocean ecosystems that are being driven into extinction from unregulated "free market" forces.
